### **Lt. Governor Karyn Polito's Schedule for Thursday, April 12, 2018**

**BOSTON** – Tomorrow, as part of the 2018 STEM Career Pathway Grants Program, Lt. Governor Karyn Polito will meet with representatives from Project Lead the Way, Massachusetts STEM Hub and Worcester Polytechnic Institute (WPI) to plan for Project Lead the Way implementation in 73 schools across the Commonwealth.

She will then join Secretary of Education Jim Peyser, Secretary of Labor and Workforce Development Rosalin Acosta, Holyoke Mayor Alex Morse, locally elected officials, representatives from Holyoke Community College (HCC) and MGM Resorts at a ribbon cutting ceremony for the new HCC MGM Culinary Arts Institute.

Afterwards, she will join local officials in Chesterfield to highlight the ongoing progress to close the broadband connectivity gap for unserved residences and businesses in Last Mile communities.
